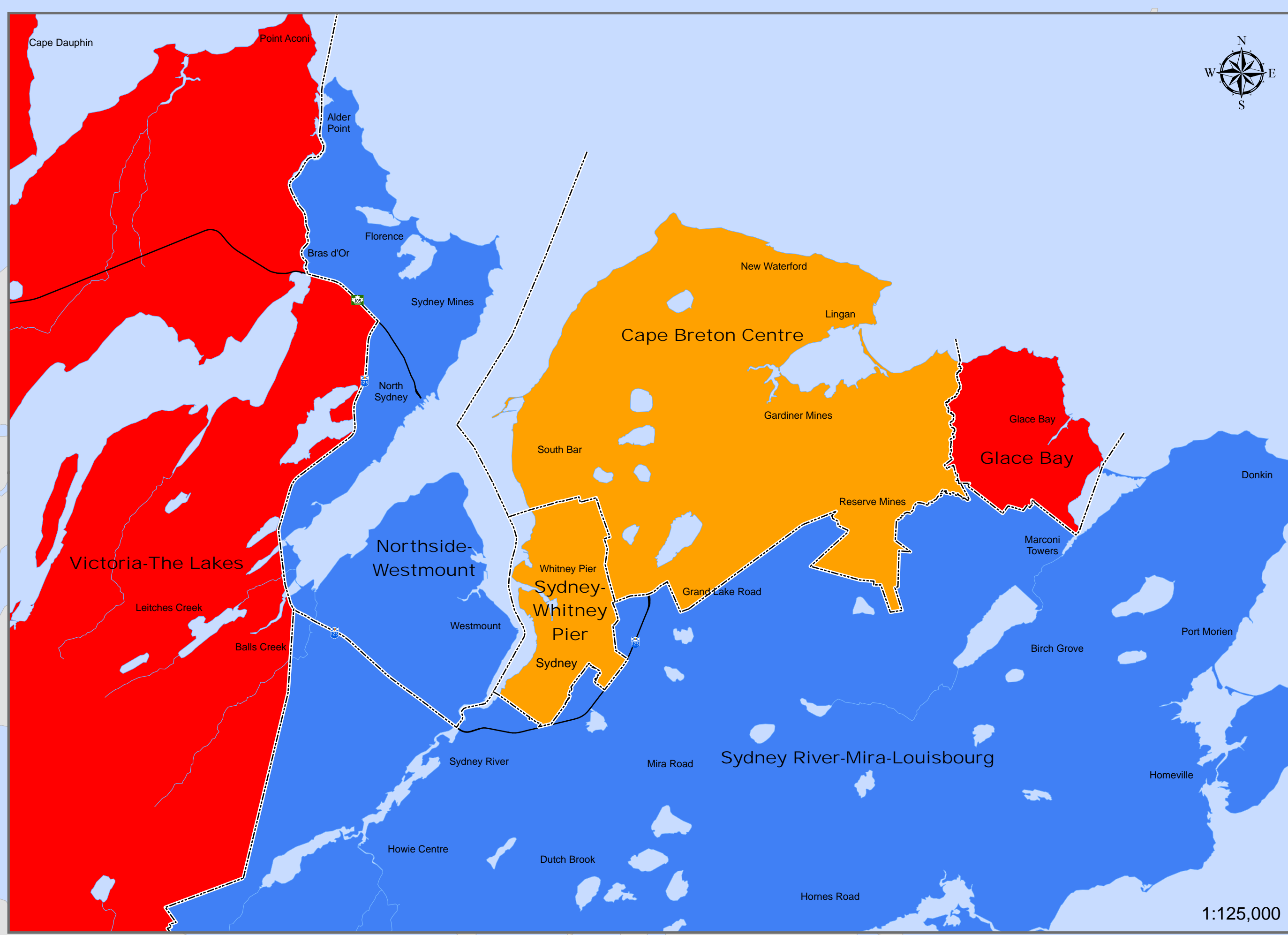

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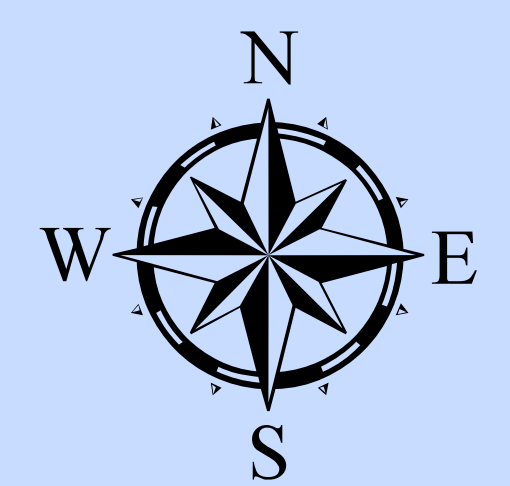
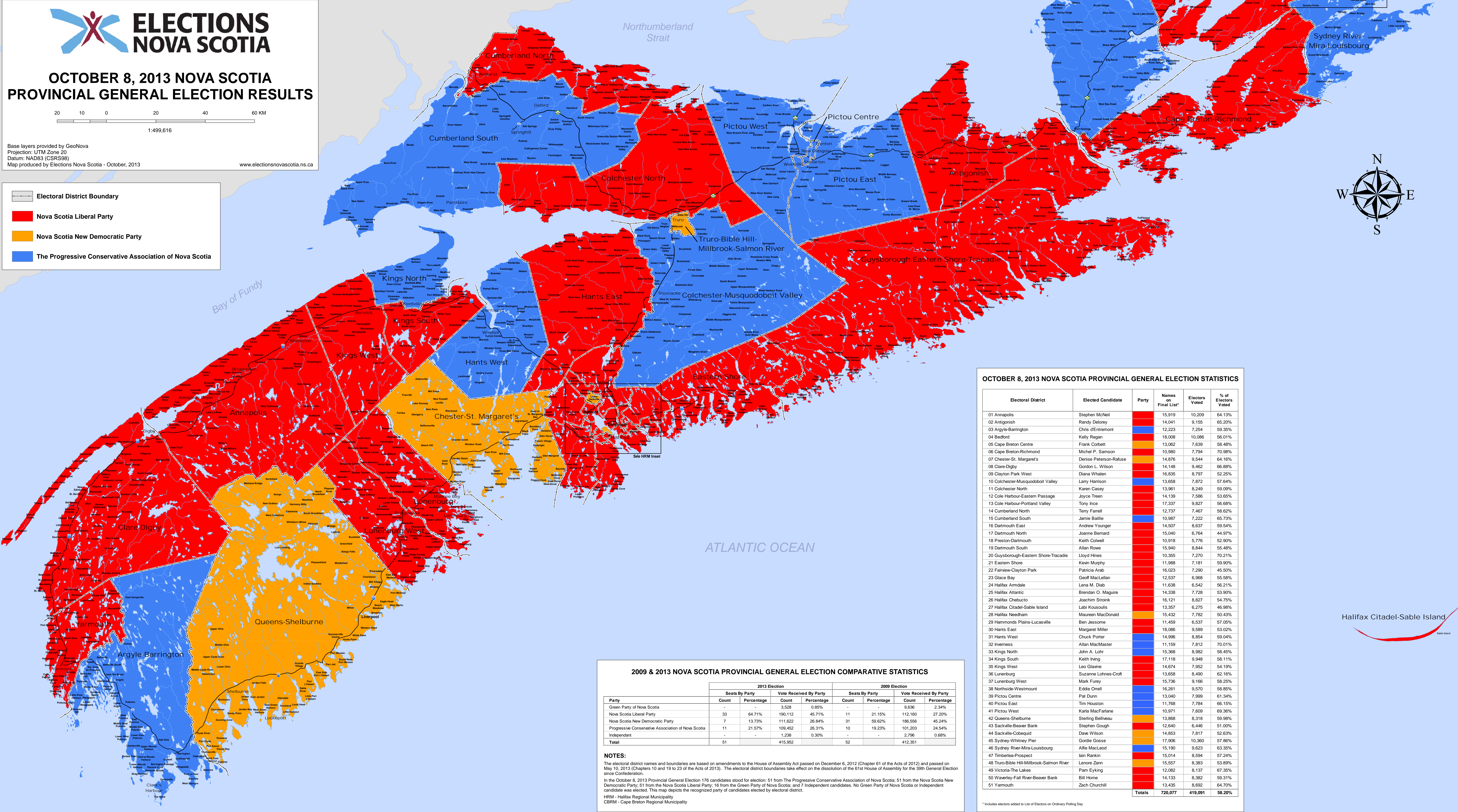

 The electoral district names and boundaries are based on amendments to the House of Assembly Act passed on December 6, 2012 (Chapter 61 of the Acts of 2012) and passed on May 10, 2013 (Chapters 10 and 19 of the Acts of 2013). The electoral district boundaries take effect on the dissolution of the 61st House of Assembly for the 39th General Election since Confederation.
 In the October 8, 2013 Provincial General Election 176 candidates stood for election: 51 from The Progressive Conservative Association of Nova Scotia; 51 from the Nova Scotia New Democratic Party; 51 from the Nova Scotia Liberal Party; 16 from the Green Party of Nova Scotia; and 7 Independent candidates. No Green Party of Nova Scotia or Independent candidate was elected. This map depicts the recognized party of candidates elected by electoral district.
