## Instructions on How to Complete the Application for Write-In Ballot

Fill in all sections of the form and print clearly.

- Name:** Enter your full name, including your middle name. Do not use nicknames, shortened names, or initials. This information helps to improve accuracy of the list of electors.
- Gender (Sex):** This information helps to identify electors.
- Date of birth:** This information **will not** appear on the list of electors used at the poll; it is confidential. The date of birth helps to identify electors with the same name.
- Current civic address:** This is your street address and not a post office box or rural route number. It identifies the polling division in which you live.
- Previous civic address:** Your name may appear on the list of electors at your previous address if you have recently moved. If so, your name will be transferred to your current address.
- Mailing address:** Fill in only if you get your mail at this address, and not at your civic address.
- Contact information:** This information **will not** appear on the list of electors. It will be used by the returning office staff to contact you if more information is required about this application. Please provide an alternative phone number where you can be contacted if you are away from home.
- Address to send ballot kit:** If the ballot is to be sent to your mailing address check the box in Section 8. If the ballot kit is to be sent to a different address, make sure that you have included the entire address so that you will receive the ballot kit.
- Declaration:** You must declare that you are qualified to vote, that you have not voted, and you understand that once this application is approved you will have been marked as having voted at this election.

**You must sign and date the declaration.**
