

# Transposition of Votes from the 2017 Provincial General Election to 2019 Electoral District Boundaries April 12, 2021



# **Background**

In the fall of 2019, the Nova Scotia House of Assembly legislated 55 electoral district boundaries as recommended by the Electoral Boundaries Commission. These new district boundaries will be used for the  $41^{\rm st}$  provincial general election in Nova Scotia when it is called.

When new electoral boundaries are enacted, Elections Nova Scotia prepares a report to illustrate the transposition of votes from the previous provincial general election based on the new electoral boundaries. The following report outlines the methodology used to determine which party would have come first and which second within the new electoral district boundaries.

# Methodology

To determine which party came first and which came second within the new 55 electoral district boundaries as approved by the House of Assembly in 2019, the following methodology was used.

### A) Base Data

For each of the 51 electoral districts that existed on May 30, 2017, the following base data was considered to calculate the estimated vote transposition:

- 1) The 2017 Provincial General Election (PGE) vote count results for each registered political party that fielded a candidate at the electoral district and for independent candidates, for all the polls held at each of the 51 electoral districts:
  - Election day polls,
  - Early voting polls:
    - o advance polls,
    - o in-district write-in ballot poll,
    - o out-of-district write-in ballot poll,
    - o in-district returning office continuous poll,
    - out-of-district continuous poll
- 2) The digital electoral district boundaries for the 51 electoral districts distribution used in the 2017 PGE.
- 3) The digital polling divisions boundaries in each electoral district as used in the 2017 PGE.
- 4) The digital electoral district boundaries as approved by the House of Assembly in 2019 for the new 55 electoral districts.
- 5) The spatial distribution of the civic addresses in Nova Scotia as of October 2019.

6) The electors as registered on the Register of Electors at the Province's civic addresses as of October 2019.

### B) Calculation methodology

Using Geographic Information System (GIS) tools and the above datasets the following steps were followed to calculate the estimated vote transposition:

- 1) For transposing the votes cast at election day polls, the new 55 electoral district boundaries of the 2019 electoral district boundary distribution, were overlayed over the polling divisions boundaries in each of the 51 electoral districts as used in the 2017 PGE, and determined:
  - Which of the 2017 polling divisions was wholly contained within a new 2019 electoral district.
  - ii. Which of the 2017 polling divisions was split by the boundary of a 2019 electoral district. For those polling divisions, the GIS tool calculated the proportion of the electors for each split area in the following manner:
    - Extract the civic addresses located within each split of the polling division area.
    - > Sum up the total number of registered electors living at civic address in that polling division.
    - > Sum up the total number of registered electors living at civic addresses located in each of the split areas for that polling division.
    - ➤ Determine the proportion of the 2017 registered electors residing within each split piece to the total electors within the polling division.
    - The proportional distribution of registered electors for each polling division split piece was then multiplied by the votes cast for each party and independent candidate in that poll. The resultant number of votes by party was then attributed to the 2019 electoral district that incorporated that piece of the polling division.
    - Where a whole polling division was absorbed by one of the new 2019 electoral districts, all (100%) the votes cast for each party and independent candidate at that poll were attributed to the new district.
- 2) For transposing the votes cast at early voting polls, the new 55 electoral district boundaries of the 2019 electoral district boundary distribution, were overlayed over the 51 electoral districts boundaries as used in the 2017 PGE, and determined:
  - i. Which of the 2017 electoral districts was wholly contained within a new 2019 electoral district.

- ii. Which of the 2017 electoral districts was split by the boundary of a new 2019 electoral district. For those districts, the GIS tool calculated the proportion of the electors for each split area as described above.
- iii. For transposing the votes cast at the early voting polls, the proportional distribution of registered electors for each electoral district split was then multiplied by the votes cast for each party and independent candidate at each early voting poll. The resultant number of votes by party was then attributed to the 2019 electoral district that incorporated that piece of the electoral district.
- iv. Where a whole electoral district was absorbed by one of the new 2019 electoral districts, all (100%) the votes cast for each party and independent candidate at that early voting poll were attributed to the new district.
- 3) When all votes were re-distributed as above into the new 2019 electoral districts boundaries the total votes cast for each party was summed up and the parties who came first and second were determined for that electoral district.
