NOTICE is hereby given that a plebiscite will be held in the plebiscite area shown highlighted on the above map on:
Tuesday, September 20, 2011
 8:00 am to 7:00 pm

FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the question to be voted on at this plebiscite is:

Are you in favour of the sale of liquor in your municipality in accordance with the Liquor Control Act? Yes No

WHO MAY VOTE:

A person may be included on the list of electors for a polling division if the person meets all of the following criteria:
 (a) the person is 19 years of age, or will be 19 years of age as of September 20, 2011;
 (b) the person is a Canadian citizen;
 (c) the person has been ordinarily resident in the plebiscite area since February 18, 2011.

Purpose of the plebiscite is to ask residents of District 2 whether they are in favour of permitting the sale of alcohol within the district. The plebiscite was triggered by a proposal from a farm winery/distillery outlet in the Port Williams area.

Voter Information Cards have been sent to eligible electors on the preliminary list of electors. Other qualified electors may vote at the advance or ordinary polls by presenting identification and proof of residency.
